EUbuzz Info Day for the debate clubs from the North of Montenegro was organized in the Berane Grammar

Ministry of European Affairs signed a Memorandum on Cooperation with the faculties of philology of the University of Montenegro and University of Donja Gorica. The aim of the cooperation is implementation of activities and projects of common interest, primarily in the fields of preparation of Montenegrin version of the European acquis, training of students in the field of translation of European documents and using the computer assisted translation tools, translation in national and European institutions and standardization of Montenegrin terminology in specific fields. Chief negotiator of Montenegro with the European Union Predrag Zenović clarified that the corps of European legislation at that moment contained about 250,000 pages of the Official Journal of the EU, and that the preparation of the national version of field-specific and legal texts was a test of preparedness of the state to deal with the tasks that membership in the EU brought. "Preparation of the national version of the EU acquis is the most demanding translation-legal endeavour in Montenegrin history, where we have to have in mind in particularly the specificities of translation of legal text, as the so called "high risk texts". After we become an EU Member State these texts will produce legal effect and have a direct impact on the processes within the society and the rights of individuals", said Zenović.
